

His political career began in 1993, when he was first elected to the Elko City Council, serving there for eight years. He was later elected to the Elko County Commission, and subsequently to the Nevada State Assembly in 2010. During the 2019 Legislative Session, John was the Co-Deputy Minority Leader and served on the Assembly Government Affairs, Assembly Growth and Infrastructure, and Assembly Natural Resources, Agriculture and Mining Committees. He was Chair of the Government Affairs Committee and Speaker Pro Tempore in 2015. Assemblyman Ellison's efforts led to him receiving the highest score of any Nevada legislator from both the American Conservative Union and Nevada Policy Research Institute for the 80th Legislative Session.
