

So take your place of honor Among those who have gone before And know you will be remembered For now and evermore




Chinese third graders are learning multi-variable calculus. Our third graders are being taught that "men can have babies." This will not end well.

A big thank you goes out to Stavros Anthony, our Lt. Governor, for sharing time with our club this month both at the reception and the monthly luncheon.






