



What is the Club Girls? The Club Girls is an informal network of all the Women's Republican clubs in Washoe County.

What is the purpose of the Club Girls? The purpose of the Club Girls is to form a cohesive group of like-minded Republicans (men and women) whose goal is to work together for the common good of the Republican Party; i.e., first and foremost, getting Republicans elected. The basic premise is that while we have different clubs of differing sizes that meet on different dates and time of day, our basic principles and objectives are the same. 



STATUE OF LIBERTY

"Give me your tired, your poor,
Your huddled masses yearning to breathe free,

One of the most famous monuments in American history, the Statue of Liberty was built by France and dedicated in 1886 as a gift of friendship to the United States. Erected on an island in New York Harbor at enormous cost, the 305-foot copper colossus has greeted generations of immigrants arriving in the United States seeking a better life and the promise of freedom.

The statue is placed on Liberty Island, which was named Bedloe's Island until 1956, when the name was officially changed. The statue is based on the Colossus of Rhodes, a giant statue in Greece that was one of the Seven Wonders of the World, before its destruction in an earthquake in 226 B.C.

The same architect who later built the famous Eiffel Tower in Paris, designed Lady Liberty's "skeleton," a system of steel girders that keeps the thin copper shell in place.

A smaller replica stands in Paris.

In 1882, in NYC, 10,000-20,000 workers took unpaid time off on that day to march to honor the American worker. The parade, was filled with music, flags, and badges, ending with a huge picnic. This peaceful protest caught the attention of legislators and workers alike. By 1885, several states had considered legislation for an official "labor day," and in 1894, Congress declared the first Monday of September a national legal holiday. Today it is still celebrated with picnics, backyard BBQs and local parades, honoring the American worker.


