

Getting Ready for the 2020 Elections

What is next and how can I get involved?

The Nevada Revised Statutes requires that the major political parties hold precinct meetings and a convention every two years. In a Presidential Election year, we have a Caucus where a presidential preference vote for our choice for the U.S Presidential nominee for our party. This year, because we have an incumbent Republican President, we will only conduct our precinct meetings and have a County Convention.

What is a Precinct meeting and how does the process work?

A Precinct is the starting place of building relationships with and representing your community, particularly those registered as Republican. You will be able to find the location of your precinct meeting by going to www.washoegop.org. At the precinct meeting, members of each precinct will nominate members to the Washoe County Republican Central Committee, elect Delegates and Alternates to the County Convention and discuss what they would like to see on the Republican platform for the County, State and National Republican Party. Learn more about the process of being an elected delegate at the Precinct meetings in your area.


