



More of President Trump's Successes Did you know?



- The FDA approved more affordable generic drugs than ever before in history. And thanks to our efforts, many drug companies are freezing or reversing planned price increases.
- We reformed the Medicare program to stop hospitals from overcharging low-income seniors on their drugs—saving seniors hundreds of millions of dollars this year alone.

- Signed the "Allow States and Victims to Fight Online Sex Trafficking Act" (FOSTA), which
 includes the "Stop Enabling Sex Traffickers Act" (SESTA) which both give law enforcement
 and victims new tools to fight sex trafficking.
- Signed the biggest wilderness protection & conservation bill in a decade and designated 375,000 acres as protected land.
- Signed the Save our Seas Act which funds \$10 million per year to clean tons of plastic & garbage from the ocean.

Why the Electoral College Makes Sense

- There are 3,141 counties in the United States. Trump won 3,084 of them (98.1%). Clinton won 57.
- There are 62 counties in New York State. Trump won 46 of them. Clinton won 16.
- Clinton won the popular vote by approx. 1.5 million votes. In the 5 counties that encompass NYC, (Bronx, Brooklyn, Manhattan, Richmond & Queens) Clinton received over 2 million more votes than Trump. (Clinton won 4 of these counties; Trump won Richmond)
- Therefore, these 5 counties alone more than accounted for Clinton winning the popular vote
 of the entire country. These 5 counties comprise 319 square miles. The United States is
 comprised of 3,797,000 square miles.
- When you have a country that encompasses almost 4 million square miles of territory, it
 would be ludicrous to even suggest that the vote of those who inhabit a mere 319 square
 miles should dictate the outcome of a national election.
- Large, densely populated Democrat cities (NYC, Chicago, LA, etc.) DO NOT and SHOULD NOT speak for the rest of our country!

And...it's been verified and documented that those aforementioned 319 square miles are where the majority of our nation's problems foment.



JO Marshall Memorial Scholarship Fund

The Jo Marshall Memorial Scholarship Fund was created in 2001 in memory of Jo Marshall, who was a Boulder City RW - BOD, Past President and NvFRW Southern Director.

Two \$1,000.00 scholarships will be awarded, one to a Northern Nevada applicant and one to a Southern Nevada applicant. Female, Republican students attending a Nevada institute of Higher Learning are eligible to apply for a scholarship.

Funding for these scholarships is provided by the designated \$100.00 donations given directly to the scholarship fund by each club.

Each NvFRW club president may submit a maximum of two (2) sponsored applications. All applications must be received by the Jo Marshall Scholarship Chair by September 1, 2020. The scholarships will be awarded on or before October 1, 2020.

Jo Marshall Scholarship Guidelines/Criteria for an Application

Applicant Criteria for Consideration

- Must be a female resident of Nevada and a registered Republican
- Must be enrolled as a "degree seeking" student in her Sophomore, Junior, or Senior year, or as a Graduate Student at a Nevada Institute of Higher Learning
- Must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 and have carried 12 credit hours in the semester prior to September 1, 2019
- Must be sponsored by a NvFRW Club and the application signed by the President and/or First Vice President of the sponsoring Club (*Each club may submit a maximum of two sponsored applications for consideration*)

Applicant's Responsibilities for consideration

- Must submit two letters of recommendation from non-relatives
- Must submit a biographical essay describing a significant achievement and a time when the applicant grew as a person
- Must submit the most recent official university transcript available and proof of current registration
