

Karen Reed is the mother of one daughter and has five grandsons and two granddaughters, aged 12 to 14, and is married to Michael Reed. Her family originated from Buffalo, NY and came out West in 1982. When she moved to Sparks in 2005, she continued her career as a medical administrator until 2013. At that time, she began working with the Reno Aces, where she enjoyed many different positions for 10 years. In addition, Karen is an avid political volunteer, keeping Nevada strong. Scuba diving and swimming are among her many passions. She hopes when she gets back in the water with one leg kicking, it doesn't spin her in circles. Ha! Karen's sense of humor has no boundaries and keeps friends and family laughing. She delightfully lights up every room that she enters. Karen is very special woman!

In July 2021, Karen underwent reconstructive surgery on her left ankle and foot. She fell ill in May 2023 and spent two weeks in intensive care. She was diagnosed with the deadly MRSA infection (methicillin-resistant staphylococcus aureus), which laid dormant for two years. Her major organs were shutting down. After 67 days, 4 surgeries and fighting for her life, Karen was allowed to go home. That, however, was short lived. Karen was re-admitted two weeks later when the MRSA infection penetrated her bones and was rapidly spreading. The only option recommended was amputation of her left leg below the knee to save her life. She spent another 12 days of hospitalization with physical and emotional preparation for a prosthetic leg. The healing process has been a struggle as are the insurmountable medical bills. Imagine GETTING KAREN BACK ON BOTH FEET by helping to provide her with the funds for a prosthetic leg.

#### **Veterans Day History**

The history of Veterans Day is fascinating, as it's a holiday that was created in the U.S. and only celebrated in its exact form here. However, other countries have holidays that resemble it. Once an international day to mark the end of World War I, it's now a day when Americans thank the men and women in their lives who served in the nation's military – no matter how, when, or for how long. Veterans Day was originally called Armistice Day, and Armistice Day was celebrated worldwide as the end of the first World War. Armistice Day was created to mark the end of the first truly multinational conflict, or "the war to end all wars." So what is Armistice Day? Well, the name comes from the armistice that the Allies formed with Germany to pause all fighting, which occurred at 11:00 a.m. on November 11th. The 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month. The first time that the name "Veterans Day" was used was in 1947 in Birmingham, Alabama. A WWII Vet named Raymond Weeks organized the first "National Veterans Day," complete with parades and festivities. Eventually, Kansas U.S. Representative Edward Rees proposed a bill to officially change the holiday's name to Veterans Day. In 1954, President Eisenhower signed the final bill that would establish Armistice Day as Veterans Day.

#### What Does Active Membership Look Like?

#### RIGHTS OF MEMBERS:

- 1. To attend meetings
- 2. To be notified of meetings
- 3. To make and second motions
- 4. To debate the questions
- 5. To vote on all motions
- To state your case before the Board of committee
- 7. To serve on committees
- 8. To serve as an officer
- 9. To help elect officers
- 10. To object to disagreeable motions

#### REMEMBER!

- 1. Members have more rights than the president.
- Express your opinions while in the meetings, and do NOT criticize to others AFTER the meeting.
- If you can do better, offer your services; don't criticize unless you are willing to do the job yourself.

#### RESPONSIBILITIES OF MEMBERSHIP

- 1. To attend and remain to the end of meetings
- 2. To cheerfully pay dues and fees
- 3. To read and understand all bylaws and rules of Club
- 4. To take your turn in serving on committees
- 5. To support with money and time for the activities
- To learn the correct way to make motions to carry out the business
- To express opinions on questions while IN the meetings and while the motion is on the floor
- To amend motions if they don't express the need of the majority
- To know when motions should be sent to a committee for further information
- To immediately call "Point of Order" when you see a rule has been broken
- To appeal from a decision of the chair on a point of order if you disagree with the decision
- When a discussion has gone on too long, use "Call the Question"
- To know that motions that limit or take away a privilege (like voting) requires a 2/3 vote
